Human Intellect

is the least of the spirits & the most remote
from the perfection of the Divine Intelligence

The Angels

"Thinking Substances" -

Pure Subsistent forms.

Do not inform matter

Free from the necessities of Time
from Movement

from Generation & Corruption

from the Divisions of Space

from the materiality of Individuation (?)
of materia signata

Each concentrates in himself more
metaphysical stability (?) than the whole human
race together

Each is a specific type, -

- Exhausts the perfection of
his essence -

Born for the first moment to the
complete fullness of their natural possibilities
Incorrupt by definition

Each Transparent to his own glance

? Each with full perception of his own
substance by that substance

At a single leap knowing God - by analogy
but in what a mirror of splendour.

Their intellect always 'in act' with regard to
intelligible objects.
