## Citation

VERY REVEREND EDWARD B. BUNN, S.J.  
*Doctor of Laws*  
*Honoris Causa*

The founding fathers of this infant republic were completing ratification of the Constitution which was to form the basis of its government in 1879 when the cherished ideal of Bishop John Carroll of Baltimore became a reality with the establishment of the young nation's first Catholic college at Georgetown.

In this year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, this Constitution and this University have provided 175 years of distinguished service to the causes for which they were established. The former has bred a nation of premier rank among the world's governments; the latter has attained eminence as one of our leading educational institutions.

Latest in the chain of educators who have directed Georgetown University along the path of excellence is its incumbent president, the Very Reverend Edward B. Bunn of the Society of Jesus. A noted teacher and educational leader in his own right, Father Bunn has directed his university since 1952, during its greatest era of intellectual and physical expansion.

Father Bunn, a native of Baltimore, entered the Society of Jesus in 1919 and was ordained 10 years later. He began his career as a teacher in 1923 as Professor of Drama at Fordham University. He subsequently was appointed Dean of Students at Brooklyn Preparatory School; Professor of Psychology at Canisius College and at Fordham University; President of Loyola College, Baltimore; Director of Studies for the Maryland Province of the Society of Jesus; and Regent of the Dental and Nursing Schools at Georgetown University.

A member of virtually every major national educational association, Father Bunn has also served with distinction on numerous civic, professional and governmental organizations. He is a member of the Newcomen Society of North America; Washington trustee of the Federal City Council; a member of the Board of Consultants of the National War College; a member of the Board of Trustees for the Washington Center for Metropolitan Studies; and Chairman of the Committee for Inter-University Cooperation in Graduate Study.

Father Bunn has been honored alike by foreign governments and our own nation's leading educational institutions. He holds the Commander's Cross of the Order of Merit of the Federal Republic of Germany; the Order of Merit in the Rank of the Grand Cross of Peru; and the Grand Gold Badge of Honor of the Republic of Austria. He has been awarded honorary degrees by Fordham University, Brandeis University, Boston College and Notre Dame University.

He is a graduate of Loyola College; holds a master's degree from Saint-Andrew-on-the-Hudson; undertook advanced study at Woodstock College; and holds a doctorate from the Gregorian University, Rome.

For his splendid adherence to the principles of the founder of Georgetown University, Bishop John Carroll; for his singular service to that institution and to the whole of higher education; for his distinctive achievements as teacher, administrator and citizen, Seattle University is proud to confer upon the Very Reverend Edward B. Bunn of the Society of Jesus its highest award, the degree of Doctor of Laws, Honoris Causa.

The chief architect of what President Johnson has termed "the most significant education bill in the history of the Republic" is a former schoolteacher whose concern for the well-being of her fellow citizens has carried her from the classroom to the halls of Congress.

Edith Starrett Green, United States Representative from the Third Congressional District in the State of Oregon, has been a vital force in the promotion of social legislation since her first successful bid for a congressional seat in 1954.

During the decade which has passed since that time, she has sponsored a broad spectrum of legislation, including programs providing for aid to handicapped children; for expanded nursing education; for techniques to reduce juvenile delinquency; for broader minimum wage coverage; for equal pay opportunities for women; for liberalized immigration laws; for extension of Social Security benefits and for the establishment of the Arms Control and Disarmament Agency.

Her report, "The Federal Government and Education," presented to the 88th Congress, is the most comprehensive analysis yet made of the Federal Government's investment in higher education and has established guidelines for future laws in this increasingly critical area. She has been an exemplary participant in the current study and discussion of congressional ethics and conflict-of-interest.

Mrs. Green is a member of the President's Commission on the Status of Women; the United States National Committee to UNESCO; and two commissions of the National Council of Churches.

She has been honored by awards from diverse organizations. These include the Brotherhood Award of B'nai B'rith; the Woman of the Year Award of the AMVETS Auxiliary; the Distinguished Service Award of the National Association of Colored Women's Clubs; and special citations by the Young Women's Christian Association and the National Council of Jewish Women.

Educated in schools in our neighboring state, she attended Willamette University there, holds her bachelor's degree in science from the University of Oregon; and subsequently took advanced studies at Stanford University. She has received honorary degrees conferred by the University of Alaska, Culver-Stockton College, Eureka College and Gonzaga University.

For her immeasurable contribution to the advancement of higher education; for her demonstrated interest in humanistic legislation; for her superior qualities as a teacher, parent and lawmaker, Seattle University is proud to confer upon Edith Starrett Green its highest award, the degree of Doctor of Laws, *Honoris Causa*.

## Academic Costume

The caps, gowns and hoods universally worn by faculties and candidates for degrees at graduating exercises are a costume dating back to the Twelfth Century. In medieval days the scholars were clerics; the buildings were cold, capes and hoods were required for warmth, and robes of scholars were similar to the cassocks of the clerics.

In the course of years of development, caps with tassels have replaced capes for the head covering, the hooded cape has been modified into the present hood, and the gowns with long flowing sleeves have been redesigned to indicate the character of the degree of the wearer. In 1893, a student movement in the United States endorsed academic apparel as overcoming awkwardness and difference in dress at graduation exercises and resulted in a standardization of academic costume in this country.

The Intercollegiate Code, adopted in 1895, recognizes three styles of gowns: a bachelor's gown, a master's gown, and a doctor's gown. The differences in these gowns are mainly in the cut and shape of the sleeves and in the trimming. Hoods are also recognized for each of the above degrees and vary in shape, size and length. The shell of the hood matches the black material of the gown, and is lined with the color or colors of the institution conferring the degree. The velvet bordering of the hood is of a color indicative of the field of learning to which the degree pertains. The Oxford cap, proper for all degrees, is worn both indoors and outdoors with academic costume. The tassel, worn over the left eye once the degree is conferred, is also symbolic of the degree and conforms to the code of colors for hood trimming. Prior to the actual conferring of the degree the tassel is worn over the right eye. Holders of Doctor's degrees are entitled to wear a gold tassel. The tassel of a bachelor's degree indicates the field in which the degree is granted. The color for each field of learning follows:
