RT. REVEREND IVOL IRA CURTIS

Upon a clergyman whose religious dedication transcends sectarianism and whose love of humanity made his ten years as Bishop of the Olympia diocese a memorable and progressive era. To a man who saw the fruits of his labor and that of others for the cause of ecumenism result in a meaningful dialogue between all faiths of the Puget Sound area.

To a graduate of Carleton College in Minnesota, who was ordained to the diaconate in 1935, the priesthood in 1936, and consecrated Bishop in 1964. To one who has not ceased responding to God's "call to action" since that time; from his early work as a parish rector in Michigan, New York, and California, to his recent years as the Northwest leader of the Episcopal community.

Upon Ivola Ira Curtis, now retired from actively administering to God's people as Bishop of Olympia, who is a source of inspiration to any who encounter him, Seattle University confers the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

DANIEL JACKSON EVANS

Upon a distinguished public servant whose exemplary political career in this State of Washington stands out among the nation's political leaders and restores the people's faith in their government. To a man who considers the needs and desires of Washington citizens as a high priority of the office of Governor.

To a man whose career as a civil engineer was altered by the will of the voters of Washington, who, recognizing the leadership that he brought to the State Legislature, elected him their Governor in 1964, and by re-election made him the only three-term Governor in the State's history.

To one who, in his 12 years as chief executive, has fought for progressive legislation in areas of education, energy, and social issues. Particularly relevant to Seattle University, he has been a consistent supporter of private higher education in this State.

Upon this Governor, Daniel Jackson Evans, a truly distinguished public servant, Seattle University confers the degree of Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*.

LESTER ROSAIRE SAUVAGE, M.D., F.A.C.S.

Upon a surgeon and researcher; a brilliant and articulate spokesman for the medical profession. Upon a man whose work each day is best explained in the words of Thomas Mann: "All interest in disease and death is only another expression of interest in life, as is proven by the humanistic faculty of medicine . . ." That "humanistic faculty of medicine" is personified in Dr. Lester Sauvage, a man who entered the private practice of pediatric and cardiovascular surgery in Seattle 17 years ago.

To a man whose acute grasp of the scientific method in the context of ethical principles has shaped his extensive research in cardiovascular surgery, and whose perseverance has led to revolutionary surgical techniques, saving the lives of many of his fellow human beings.

Upon this surgeon, a devout Christian, a Jesuit graduate, the father of eight children and a true humanitarian, who lives a doctor's life of self-sacrifice each day in dedicated service to mankind, Seattle University confers the degree of Doctor of Humanities, *honoris causa*.

WILLIAM J. BAROODY, JR.

Upon a student of government and a notable member of the Executive Branch of the United States. To one whose career in government service began in 1958 as an officer in the United States Navy, and whose goals have guided him through eight years of service in the Legislative Branch of Government, four years as Deputy Secretary of Defense, and three years as Assistant to the President of the United States.

To a man with ideals of honesty and dedication in service to God and country; to a graduate of Holy Cross College whose Christian values reflect the Jesuit tradition of education.

To a government official who symbolizes a new generation of men and women intent on giving shape and direction to our country at a time when America is undergoing a critical self-analysis of its system of government.

Upon William J. Baroody, Jr., recipient in 1973 of the highest award presented to a civilian by the Department of Defense, Seattle University confers the degree, Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*.

Academic Costume

The caps, gowns and hoods universally worn by faculties and candidates for degrees at graduating exercises are a costume dating back to the Twelfth Century. In medieval days the scholars were clerics; the buildings were cold; capes and hoods were required for warmth, the robes of scholars were similar to the cassocks of the clerics.

In the course of years of development, caps with tassels have replaced capes for the head covering, the hooded cape has been modified into the present hood, and the gowns with long flowing sleeves have been redesigned to indicate the character of the degree of the wearer. In 1893, a student movement in the United States endorsed academic apparel as overcoming awkwardness and difference in dress at graduation exercises and resulted in a standardization of academic costume in this country.

The Intercollegiate Code, adopted in 1895, recognizes three styles of gowns: a bachelor's gown, a master's gown, and a doctor's gown. The differences in these gowns are mainly in the cut and shape of the sleeves and in the trimming. Hoods are also recognized for each of the above degrees and vary in shape, size and length. The shell of the hood matches the black material of the gown, and is lined with the color or colors of the institution conferring the degree. The velvet bordering of the hood is of a color indicative of the field of learning to which the degree pertains. The Oxford cap, proper for all degrees, is worn both indoors and outdoors with academic costume. The tassel, worn over the left eye once the degree is conferred, is also symbolic of the degree and conforms to the code of colors for hood trimming. Prior to the actual conferring of the degree the tassel is worn over the right eye. Holders of doctor's degrees are entitled to wear a gold tassel. The tassel of a bachelor's degree indicates the field in which the degree is granted. The color for each field of learning follows:
