### **WILLIAM B. HUTCHINSON**

William Hutchinson, you are a physician and humanitarian whose selfless dedication to the field of cancer research has brought us new hope.

Your years of academic preparation and your service for more than four decades as a surgeon, researcher and medical administrator are witness to your lifelong efforts to conquer this most cruel of diseases.
