Your reputation as an educational leader is recognized nationwide by your membership on the National Committee on United States-China Relations and by your presidency of the Council of Chief State School Officers.

While serving for ten years as leader of the state's public schools, you have exhibited an understanding and respect for independent education through the establishment of a private schools liaison in your office, through your membership on the Board of Trustees of the University of Puget Sound, and by your work with the School of Education at Seattle University.

ROBERT O. AND MIRIAM D. KINSEY

Miriam Kinsey, you are a woman whose life exemplifies a spirit of creativity and of sharing.

You have given unselfishly to promote an understanding and appreciation of Asian culture and art. During your years in Seattle, and now California, you have worked to share your knowledge, and your collections, of Eastern art.
