Dear Graduates,

This has been an excellent year for the Seattle University community. Since 1,468 degrees were conferred on your classmates 364 days ago, each one of you has added your personal imprint on the history of Seattle University.

Collectively, the class of 1994 was part of the record breaking 5,060 students enrolled for fall classes. The enrollment figures reflect the continued confidence of our students in the strength of our faculty and academic programs.

Professional service groups, academic honoraries, corporations, government units, and appreciative fans have all recognized the quality represented by our student body, particularly the class of '94.

Congratulations to Ryan P. Sawyer, English and philosophy major. Ryan is a finalist for a Rhodes Scholarship, His scholarly accomplishments have also earned him a Chevron Merit Scholarship, an Edmund F. Maxwell Foundation Scholarship and the General Motors Liberal Arts Excellence Award.

Robyn Cross received the Spirit of Nursing Award from the National Student Nurses Association, which honors exceptional nursing students. Cathy Sommer received the Nursing Leadership Award from the United States Air Force. The Sigma Theta Tau Award for academic excellence and professional leadership was presented to Sally Stefanich.

The George C. Marshall ROTC Award, presented to the most outstanding cadet in each university ROTC unit, was presented to Tammy Herdener, who also received a campus Leadership Award.

Against formidable competitors, a group of students from the Albers School of Business and Economics took first place in the U.S. Small Business Administration Outstanding Case competition.

While competition in the classroom was rewarded, so too were the competitive accomplishments of our student athletes. For the third year, La Shanna White was named to the NAIA All-America Basketball Team. White was also among the nominees for the Seattle Post-Intelligencer's Sports Star of the Year, marking the first time anyone was nominated three consecutive years. Jamie French, Trina Miller and Michelle Rhodes were selected to participate in the NAIA Umbro Senior Soccer Showcase in Birmingham, Alabama.

The accomplishments of our student body, nurtured by an outstanding faculty dedicated to teaching excellence, have combined to bring greater regional and national attention to Seattle University. The 1993 Gourman Report, an annual study that provides comprehensive evaluations of all major universities and colleges in the country, gave Seattle University the highest rating among all independent higher education institutions in the Pacific Northwest. From humble beginnings 103 years ago, Seattle University is now the largest independent institution in the Northwest. More than 5,000 students are enrolled in 49 undergraduate and 19 graduate programs. The university offers a doctoral program in educational leadership. Beginning this fall Seattle University will have a law school.

The 46-acre campus on Seattle's First Hill has the atmosphere of a small college. Teaching is the faculty's priority at Seattle University. Low student-to-faculty ratios and caring attitudes ensure that faculty members are readily available to students.

As an institution of higher learning, Seattle University's objective and purpose include the discussion, interpretation, and transmission of knowledge, ideas and values. Under the auspices of the Society of Jesus, Seattle University supports Christian ideals and values. It affirms the belief in unity and totality of all human knowledge, whether experiential, speculative, or divinely revealed. As a community inspired with the Spirit of Christ, the campus atmosphere encourages the development of an unbiased, liberated, and enlightened intelligence in its faculty and student body.

One of 28 Jesuit colleges in the United States, Seattle University offers a broadly based academic program, including a strong liberal arts core curriculum that prepares students for community service and personal fulfillment, as well as professional success.

One of Seattle University's marks of distinction is the nation's first graduate program in software engineering. The university is also known for innovative undergraduate programs, such as the nation's first addiction studies program and the first undergraduate program in environmental engineering in the Northwest.

The true measure of the university's excellence is the success of our graduates. Seattle University's alumni includes distinguished individuals in business, public affairs, education, the performing arts, athletics, and other fields.

The History of the Graduation Cap and Gown

American academic costume (also referred to as academic "dress" or "regalia") ad its origins in the ancient European iniversities. Apparently it was devised to distinguish academic persons such as doctor, licentiates, masters and bachelors from other parts of the population. Gowns probably were a necessity because of unheated buildings, and hoods were needed to cover the heads of medieval scholars. Most universities issued strict regulations concerning the design and use of academic dress.

As they were founded, American colleges and universities inevitably adopted the gown, hood and cap from their European antecedents. Although some common standards and practices were observed, no uniform code or system existed until late in the 19th century.

The principle features of academic dress are three: the gown, the cap and the hood. The flowing gown comes from the 12th century. It has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it completely covers any dress of rank or social standing underneath. It is black for all degrees, with pointed sleeves for the bachelor's degree; long closed sleeves for the master's degree; and round open sleeves for the doctorate degree. The gown worn for the bachelor's or master's degree has no trimmings. The gown for the doctorate degree is faced down the front with velvet and has three bars of velvet across the sleeves in the color distinctive of the faculty or discipline to which the degree pertains.

The wearing of the cap was a privilege won by freed slaves in ancient Rome, and so the academic cap is a sign of the freedom of scholarship and the responsibility and dignity with which scholarship endows the wearer. Old poetry records the cap of scholarship as square to symbolize the book, although some authorities claim that the mortar board or cap is a symbol of the masons, a privileged guild. The color of the tassel on the cap denotes the discipline.

Heraldically the hood is an inverted shield with one or more chevrons of a secondary color on the ground of the primary color of the college. The color of the facing of the hood denotes the discipline represented by the degree; the color of the lining of the hood designates the university from which the degree was granted. The length of the hood varies by academic degree. The hood for the doctorate degree is the only one with panels at the sides.

HONORARY DEGREES

Reverend Bernard J. Coughlin, SJ

Reverend Bernard J. Coughlin, of the Society of Jesus, you have had a distinguished international career as a scholar in the field of social work and as an academic administrator.

You earned degrees from Saint Louis University, the University of Southern California, and Brandeis University, from which you received your PhD in Social Work. Your teaching career includes positions at Campion High School, Boys Industrial School, and Saint Louis University. You served as dean of the School of Social Service at Saint Louis University from 1964 to 1967.

You served as a social work consultant in Guatemala, Ecuador, Chile, and Peru.

You were a Fulbright Lecturer at the Universidad de Calda in Colombia, South America in 1970. You returned one year later to a similar post at the Universidad Javriana and the Universidad Bolivariana.

You became Gonzaga University's twenty-third president in 1974. Under your leadership the university has experienced remarkable growth and success. A new library and new buildings for engineering, education, business, fine arts and athletics have been completed during your tenure.

Gonzaga University has also enjoyed significant growth in enrollment and increased financial support from alumni, foundations and the corporate world.

While steering the university toward a position among the top institutions in the region, you have also been active in numerous professional and civic organizations in the Spokane area. The Boy Scouts of America, the Economic Development Council, Higher Education Consortium, the Chamber of Commerce, the Symphony, the United Way of Spokane and the Greater Spokane Substance Abuse Council have all benefited from your involvement. In 1988-89 you served as the chair of the Greater Spokane Chamber of Commerce, the only priest ever to hold such a post.

Therefore, in recognition of your accomplishments as an educator, administrator and civic leader, upon you, Bernard J. Coughlin, SJ, Seattle University proudly confers the degree doctor of humanities, honoris causa.

Vi Hilbert

Elder Vi Hilbert, Tahqwshublo, you are an author, a teacher, and a leader of the Lushootseed people. Credited with providing major assistance in the preservation of your people's native language, you were declared a Washington State Living Treasure in 1989 by Governor Booth Gardner.

You have shared your knowledge and the history of the Lushootseed people through several books and oral narratives, recordings and lectures. People from coast to coast and others in Canada and Great Britain have enjoyed your storytelling. Your work turning oral Lushootseed into written language using a 40-character alphabet and the countless hours you spent interpreting and transcribing recorded stories from Elders of the Tribe resulted in the publication of three volumes of Skagit legends in both English and Lushootseed. These efforts led to your teaching language and literature courses in Lushootseed at the University of Washington.

You founded Lushootseed Research, a non-profit organization dedicated to the ongoing process of researching, writing, and preserving the culture of your people. You have been described as the embodiment of a Native American tradition not in search of itself, but in command of itself, culturally speaking, finding your own outlets and vehicles for expression.

Therefore, in honor of your accomplishments as a language teacher, a storyteller, a translator, a researcher and a traditional elder, upon you, Vi Hilbert, Seattle University proudly confers the degree doctor of humanities, honoris causa.

ludith Ann Mayotte

Judith Ann Mayotte, your life as an educator, television journalist and as a humanitarian represents the essence of Jesuit education.

Teaching assignments drew you to juvenile detention facilities, inner-city and suburban high schools.

You earned a PhD in historical theology from Marquette University.

Your broadcasting career included several posts with WTTW-TV, Chicago's public broadcasting station. You served as a senior researcher and producer for Turner Broadcasting's award-winning series *Portrait of America*. In 1985 you received an Emmy for writing and producing the "Washington" segment of *Portrait of America*. You received a John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation grant to write a book on long-term refugees. *Disposable People?*, *The Plight of Refugees*, published in 1992, was the result of your three-year journey, frequently at great personal risk, through the refugee camps of the Cambodians in Thailand, the Eritreans and internally displaced Sudanese in Sudan, and the Afghans in Pakistan.

You have served as a senior fellow of the Refugee Policy Group of Washington, D.C. As chair of the Women's Commission for Refugee Women and Children and a member of the board of the International Rescue Committee and Refugees International you have traveled around the world to assess refugee and repatriation issues, and the plight of internally displaced peoples.

You have testified before Congressional committees concerned with the status of refugees. You have written extensively, appeared on many broadcasts and lectured on refugee issues.

Therefore, in recognition of your accomplishments in broadcasting, your advocacy on behalf of refugees, especially women and children, your personal sacrifice and your unselfish commitment to the betterment of the human condition, upon you, Judith Ann Mayotte, Seattle University proudly confers the degree doctor of humanities, honoris causa.

Malcolm Theodore Stamper

Malcolm Theodore Stamper, after a distinguished business career, you have employed your personal energies and financial resources to help thousands learn to read through access to books.

Your remarkable business career started in 1949 with General Motors Corporation. Your work, for almost 30 years, as a corporate executive with The Boeing Company, left an indelible imprint in commercial aviation history.

The 747 jetliner, a technologically revolutionary airplane, the development of which you led, forever changed the way people travel and fostered relations among peoples around the world.

Your leadership as president and vice chairman of The Boeing Company helped

to position the company as the world's leading manufacturer of commercial aircraft.

You were named Industrialist of the Year in 1967. You received the Educator's Golden Key Award in 1970; the Elmer A. Sperry Award in 1982 and other honors from the AIEE, Georgia Institute of Technology and the Department of Health and Human Services.

Retired from the vigorousness of the corporate world, you have directed your tireless energies toward your goal of making the world more literate. You founded Storytellers, Ink, a family-funded publishing venture. Together with the American Humane Education Society, you formed Operation Outreach-USA, a not-for-profit program providing free books and in-school reading programs to schoolchildren. You have published 24 books and have placed 250,000 copies in the hands of schoolchildren. Teaching children tenderness and compassion is a major goal of your programs.

Therefore, in recognition of your remarkable career as a pioneer in commercial aviation, your dedication to eliminating illiteracy, and your concern that our youth embrace self-respect and humane values, upon you, Malcolm Theodore Stamper, Seattle University proudly confers the degree doctor of humanities, honoris causa.
