

· About Seattle University

From humble beginnings 108 years ago, Seattle University has more than 5,500 students enrolled in 44 undergraduate and 32 graduate programs, including a doctoral program in educational leadership.

The 43-acre campus on Seattle's First Hill has the atmosphere of a small college. Teaching is the faculty's priority at Seattle University. Low student-to-faculty ratios and caring attitudes ensure that faculty members are readily available to students. As an institution of higher learning, Seattle University's objective and purpose include the discussion, interpretation, and transmission of knowledge, ideas, and values.

Under the auspices of the Society of Jesus, Seattle University supports Christian ideals and values. It affirms the belief in the unity and totality of all human knowledge, whether experiential, speculative, or divinely revealed. As a community inspired with the Spirit of Christ, the campus atmosphere encourages the development of unbiased, liberated, and enlightened

intelligence in its faculty and student body.

One of 28 Jesuit colleges in the United States, Seattle University offers a broadly based academic program, including a strong liberal arts core curriculum that prepares students for community service and personal fulfillment, as well as professional success.

Seattle University has many marks of distinction, including the nation's first undergraduate program in addiction studies (1973); the only accredited ultrasound education program in the Northwest and one of the few nationally (1978); and the Northwest's first undergraduate program in environmental engineering (1990). In addition, Seattle University offered the nation's first graduate programs in software engineering (1979) and nonprofit executive leadership (1996).

The true measure of the university's excellence is the success of our graduates. Seattle University's alumni include distinguished individuals in business, public affairs, education, the performing arts, athletics, and countless other fields.

· The History of the Graduation Cap and Gown

American academic costume (also referred to as academic "dress" or "regalia") had its origins in the ancient European universities. Apparently, it was devised to distinguish academic persons, such as doctors, licentiates, masters, and bachelors from other parts of the population. Gowns probably were a necessity because of unheated buildings, and hoods were needed to cover the heads of medieval scholars. Most universities issued strict regulations concerning the design and use of academic dress.

As they were founded, American colleges and universities inevitably adopted the gown, hood, and cap from their European antecedents. Although some common standards and practices were observed, no uniform code or system existed until late in the 19th century.

The principal features of academic dress are three: the gown, the cap, and the hood. The flowing gown comes from the 12th century. It has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it completely covers any dress of rank or social standing underneath. It is most often black, with pointed sleeves for the bachelor's degree, long, closed sleeves for the master's degree, and

round, open sleeves for the doctoral degree. The gown worn for the bachelor's or master's degree has no trimmings. The gown for the doctoral degree is faced down the front with velvet and has three bars of velvet across the sleeves in the color distinctive of the faculty or discipline to which the degree pertains.

The wearing of the cap was a privilege won by freed slaves in ancient Rome, and so the academic cap is a sign of the freedom of scholarship and the responsibility and dignity with which scholarship endows the wearer. Old poetry records the cap of scholarship as square to symbolize the book, although some authorities claim that the mortar board or cap is a symbol of the masons, a privileged guild. The color of the tassel on the cap denotes the discipline. Heraldically, the hood is an inverted shield with one or more chevrons of a secondary color on the ground of the primary color of the college. The color of the facing of the hood denotes the discipline represented by the degree; the color of the lining of the hood designates the university from which the degree was granted. The length of the hood varies by academic degree. The hood for the doctoral degree is the only one with panels at the sides.

HONORARY DEGREES

. The Reverend Dr. Samuel Berry McKinney

In 1958, Reverend Dr. Samuel Berry McKinney began ministering to a small community at the Mount Zion Baptist Church. In 1998, 40 years later, Reverend McKinney retired from Mount Zion Baptist Church, having established it as one of the largest and most powerful African-American worship communities in the area. Reverend McKinney now serves as pastor emeritus.

Known for his international humanitarian efforts, social ministry, and community service, Reverend McKinney understands that community building includes those who stand outside the doors of the church, as well as those who sit inside. Throughout his lifetime, Reverend McKinney has continuously sought to help the least, the last, and the lost wherever they may be. The dedication that he has demonstrated to the building of God's kingdom at home and abroad is tireless and knows no boundaries. His tolerance is limitless.

As a champion of civil rights, he is relentless in his efforts to eradicate the racism he sees still infecting the country. He believes

strongly in the value of education as a tool of liberation, and he supports academic excellence and achievements for all.

A graduate of the Cleveland Public School System, he entered Morehouse College in 1944 but was drafted into the U.S. Army one year later. He was honorably discharged and he re-entered Morehouse College in 1947, graduating in 1949. His portrait is permanently displayed at Morehouse College as a tribute to his spiritual and social leadership.

Ebony magazine has named him one of the country's top pastors and Newsweek has called him an enduring power in the African-American community.

In recognition of Dr. McKinney's accomplishments as a pastor, his unfailing service, and spiritual and social leadership to the Mount Zion Baptist Church and the local and world community, Seattle University proudly confers the degree of doctor of humanities, honoris causa.

· The Very Reverend Michael Gerard Ryan

The Very Reverend Michael Gerard Ryan has been pastor of St. James Cathedral since 1988, directing its physical renovation and enhancing its musical and liturgical programs in order to establish St. James as a magnet parish for the entire Puget Sound region in the tradition of the great European cathedrals. At the same time, he has been a spiritual and social leader throughout the greater Seattle community, giving of his time and talents to numerous civic boards and leadership tasks.

Father Ryan was ordained at St. Peter's Basilica in Vatican City in 1966. Since then, he has served as assistant pastor at St. Patrick's Church in Tacoma; he has been director of vocations and the founding director of the Permanent Deacon Program for the Seattle Archdiocese. He has also been a faculty member, spiritual director, and director of field education for the St. Thomas

Seminary. From 1977 to 1988 he was Chancellor of the Archdiocese, and from 1984 to 1996 he served as Vicar General. Father Ryan has served on the boards of the United Way of King County, Catholic Community Services, Church Council of Greater Seattle, and the Providence Foundation.

Seattle University has enjoyed a very warm and special relationship with Father Ryan and the cathedral during his pastorship at St. James. As members of his parish, we have felt his spirit and been inspired by his ambition to contribute in a meaningful way to the spiritual and intellectual life of this community. We share this ambition and gratefully acknowledge his energy and dedication. It is for these qualities and activities that we honor him today, proudly presenting him with the degree of doctor of humanities, honoris causa.



HONORARY DEGREES

· Samuel and Althea Stroum

Sam and Althea Stroum have served their community enthusiastically, with humor and spirit and unfailing generosity. It is for these qualities that we honor them today. Raised in Massachusetts during the Great Depression, Sam saw his father's furniture business fail and was prevented from attending college. Sam enrolled instead in the New England Aircraft School where he studied airplane and engine mechanics, and then enlisted as an engineer in the U.S. Army Air Corps. Military duty brought Sam on his first trip to Seattle, in 1941. Sam and Althea were married in 1942, and settled here in 1946.

Sam and Althea will be married 57 years in August. Together they have raised a wonderful family, established their own successful business (Schucks's Auto Supply), and contributed start-up capital and vision to dozens of other thriving enterprises, including such powerhouse companies as Egghead Software,

Digital Systems, Inc., Immunex, and Starbucks. Finally, the Stroums have been a catalyst and source of support for countless local causes, contributing generously to education, the arts, human services and a variety of religious institutions, including the Jewish Federation of Greater Seattle, Jewish Family Service, Children's Hospital, and the Seattle Art Museum. Recent beneficiaries include the Stroum Jewish Community Center, and the "Samuel and Althea Stroum Grand Lobby" in Seattle's new Benaroyal Hall.

Through their passion, their personal involvement, and their philanthropy, the Stroums have had a profound impact on this community and the entire region. We thank them and honor them for their devotion and commitment to Seattle and its citizens. 


